EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS

- First-class honours degree in Medicine and Surgery, obtained at Catania University on July 8, 1976. In November he passed an examination and qualified to be a doctor by profession.
- Specialization with full marks in Neurology at Catania University, Faculty of Medicine and Surgery (June 1981).
- Specialization with full marks in Clinical Pharmacology at same University (June 1984)

PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATION

- From July 9, 1976 to Apr. 10, 1980 and from July 26, 1980 to Jan. 31, 1981 he attended as intern Catania University's Institute of Clinical Psychiatry, directed by Prof. V. Rapisarda, where he gave his services in an in-patient department and in the Institute laboratories.
- As contract professor he held a course on "Clinical and instrumental psychiatric diagnostics", supplemental to the official course of "Clinical Psychiatry" at Catania University's Faculty of Medicine and Surgery (Academic Years 1982/83, 1983/84, 1984/85).
- Winner in the state competition for the appointment of a first bracket professor, group of Clinical Psychiatry, on Nov. 8, 1986 he took up his duties as Temporary Professor of Clinical Psychiatry at Trieste University's Curriculum for the Medicine and Surgery degree.
- In 1989 he became full Professor of Clinical Psychiatry at the same University.
- He has run Trieste University's Institute of Clinical Psychiatry since 1987, as well as the Psychiatry Postgraduate School, the Psychiatric Welfare Services-oriented School; he has been the co-ordinator of the Welfare Services Short-term Curriculum, as well as of the Psychiatric and Psychosocial Rehabilitation Techniques Short-Term University Curriculum.

- From March 2008 he is Full Professor of Clinical Psychiatry at University of Catania.

SCIENTIFIC ACTIVITY

Professor's Aguglia scientific production consist of about 450 works. Most of them, of an experimental nature, deal with issues concerning psychopharmacology, psychiatric epidemiology, alcoholism, eating disorders and dementia; others are about psychopathology and the nosographics framing of the various psychopathological emergences – the later in a joint effort with prof. T.A. Ban of the Vanderbilt University, Nashville, Tennessee.
