

Trine Munk-Olsen

Dr. Trine Munk-Olsen is an associate professor at the National Centre for Register-Based Research, Aarhus University, Denmark. She has done research in the field of perinatal psychiatry for several years and uses information from Danish population registries to perform large scale epidemiologic studies. Her main research interests are within postpartum mental disorders, and she aims at conducting studies which describe the magnitude and timing of risk of mental disorders after childbirth. She also studies risk factors for these potentially devastating disorders and is especially interested in the triggering of bipolar affective disorder after childbirth.

Dr. Munk-Olsen currently receives funding from The Lundbeck Foundation Initiative for Integrative Psychiatric Research, iPSYCH, Denmark to cover her work in perinatal mental health.
